

1. INTRODUCTION

Goldens Bridge Hamlet Organization ("GBHO") wants you to be familiar with how we collect, use and disclose information from and about you because we respect your concerns about privacy, and we want to maintain your trust.

This Privacy Notice applies to the types of information we collect from all sources, including in connection with our Website as well as any personal financial or other information we may receive through the US Postal Service or private carriers, how we use it, and with whom we share it. We also describe the measures we take to protect the information, your options for choice and access, and how you can contact us about privacy practices. By using our Website you acknowledge that you have read and accept this Privacy Notice. Your decision to use the GBHO website and provide any personal data is voluntary. We indicate below what types of personal data we collect. You may choose not to submit requested information online or otherwise, or may choose to restrict the use of cookies. The GBHO Website is directed to a general audience; it is not targeted to, and does not knowingly collect personal data from minors under 18 years of age. We request that these individuals do not provide personal data through our Website.

2. WHAT WE COLLECT

For purposes of this Privacy Notice the term "personal data" is the information that identifies you as an individual or relates to an identifiable person. GBHO collects personal data that you submit to us. This includes:

- Your email address when you communicate this information to us either through the website or through an email directly to our email address
- Your name and address when you correspond with us via carriers such as the United States Postal Service, UPS or Federal Express
- Personally identifiable financial information such as your checking or bank account number when you make a financial contribution to our organization. **Note that GBHO currently does not accept any financial contributions through our website; rather all such contributions are received through the US mail, private carriers, or through person to person donations**
- Any information that is not intended to reveal your specific identity to us, such as browser information, usage data, information collected through cookies and other technologies, demographic information, geolocation data obtained with your consent where required by applicable law, and aggregated information
- Our Website uses cookies and other tracking technologies to function effectively and deliver certain features. For more information about how we use please refer to the Notice Regarding Use of Cookies. Our website may also be linked either directly or indirectly to sites or apps operated by third parties, and which in turn may carry additional apps, advertisements or features. These third party sites may use automated means to collect information about you and your use of these features.

GBHO is not responsible for the privacy practices of such third parties, and once you leave our website to go to a third party site you should check that third party site's privacy notice.

3. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND OTHER INFORMATION

We may use your personal data consistent with our mission to preserve the historic and natural beauty of the Hamlet of Goldens Bridge, drive initiatives that provide a positive impact for its residents and work closely with public officials and local merchants to ensure the future progress of Goldens Bridge. This may include providing your name, address and email address to both elected and appointed public officials in connection with initiatives that we may undertake for the benefit of the Hamlet of Goldens Bridge. We may contact you directly to take action with respect to such initiatives. We may also contact you directly to raise funds to support such initiatives or to help finance our organization.

4. HOW WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND OTHER INFORMATION

As noted above we may share your name and/or address or email address with elected and appointed public officials with respect to laws, rules, regulations or initiatives related to our mission. In addition, we may share your personal data with non-affiliated third parties when sharing is permitted by you or authorized by this Privacy Notice.

GBHO WILL NEVER SELL YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION TO ANY THIRD PARTY, NOR SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION WITH ANY THIRD PARTY FOR ANY COMMERCIAL OR MARKETING PURPOSE OR FOR ANY PURPOSE UNRELATED TO OUR MISSION WITHOUT YOUR PRIOR WRITTEN PERMISSION.

5. HOW WE PROTECT AND RETAIN PERSONAL DATA

GBHO uses a combination of administrative, technical, personnel and physical measures to safeguard personal data in its possession against accidental, unlawful or unauthorized loss, use, access, disclosure or modification. We make reasonable efforts to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk of the processing, taking into account the costs of implementation and nature of the processing of personal data. However, no one can guarantee the complete safety of your information. If you have reason to believe that your interaction with us is no longer secure please immediately notify us of the problem by contacting us in accordance with the instructions below. Additionally, we adhere to all federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations applicable to protecting your personal data.

We will retain your personal data for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Notice unless a longer retention period is required or allowed by law.
